

Minutes of PCC Committee Meeting Wednesday 3rd February 2016

1. The Minutes of the 2nd December meeting were agreed, with the additional note that the singing in town on 27 November went well, apart from the torrential rain! We met on 16th December for carol singing at The Cricketers in Steep, with about 20 members attending but it was social, not a committee, meeting.
2. The Christmas concert was very successful, raising £1,263 for the Rosemary Foundation. The mayor did not attend. Selling wine was popular, with a profit of £60.12. Majestic Wines provide the wine on a sale or return basis, which is good and is much easier for transporting the hired glasses, but ask for a £1/glass deposit. A vote of thanks to the bartending team!
3. The Gilbert White singing, 6th December was fun; we were told to limit the number of singers but we could have had a few more. The January Wassail was cold but also a fun event.
4. French trip: numbers are finalised, Christine and Ysanne are checking the final count of rooms and we will then pay the hotel. Ysanne will prepare a rough itinerary/timetable to send out, and Christine will request the next instalment (£80) from those who are going. (CG, YB)
5. Ysanne will ask Carolyn to emphasis to members that if they are going on the trip or singing in any concert, it is essential to commit to attending rehearsals. (YB, CR)
6. Summer concert planning: a) Support act – Carol will ask the Petersfield Ukulele Band if they would like to join us (*Carol has since confirmed that they would*). b) Fitzroy have approached us, and we agreed to support them for the summer concert. Jenny will pass contact details to Carol and she will co-ordinate. (JC, CS)
7. The concert in aid of The Sarah Morgan Foundation in Winchester is on Wednesday 25th May (Change of date).
8. Ysanne will contact Lucky Moyo to try to arrange a workshop in October. (YB)
9. Social event – we decided there was enough going on at the moment
10. Three folders have not yet been returned since the concert; Christine and Jenny are chasing, they know who has them. (CG, JC)
11. More help is needed with the money collection, it is the same people each time. Dee will nominate committee member helper(s) to arrive early each week. (DK)
